

Adoption Process

Why adopt?

When you decide to adopt a dog from Forever Friends Humane Society AZ you are joining hundreds of thousands of people who have added to their families with a loving forever friend. You are also helping to support an organization that is there for you throughout the life of your dog.

You are quite possibly saving a life—and enhancing yours. You are also helping to support the hundreds of thousands of animals that come through the doors of organizations like ours annually.

You make a difference when you adopt from the FFHSAZ. When you adopt one dog you are advocating for all animals.

Adoption Policies and Procedures: FFHSAZ receives dogs from county shelters and individuals who are no longer able to care for their pets as well as dogs that are lost or abandoned. We are looking for people who are willing to provide permanent, loving homes for these animals.

Please consider carefully the time and money required to own a dog before you make the decision to adopt. Owning a dog is a lifetime commitment.

All dogs that are available for adoption have passed an evaluation based on their known history, health and temperament. Animals remain available for adoption as long as their good health and behavior continue. There is no time limit for how long an animal may remain with FFHSAZ. ADOPTION POLICIES

You must be 18 years of age or older to adopt a dog from FFHSAZ. A current photo ID (driver's license or state ID card) is required to process an adoption. All dogs have been spayed/neutered prior to being made available for adoption. To provide permanent identification, all animals received a microchip implant. The microchip is registered to FFHSAZ and you may choose to transfer the information to your own at the time of adoption. Adopted dogs should be seen or registered by your local veterinarian soon after adoption. We will communicate any known

health issues the first time you meet any of our dogs. FFHSAZ is a small rescue funded by a few volunteers.

FFHSAZ is unable to reimburse adopters or veterinarians for post-adoption medical expenses. Adopters assume full responsibility for the pet's care. While we hope your dog selection is successful and permanent, we are available for the life of your dog if you need to return him/her for any reason. No refunds will be given. If at any time you can no longer care for your dog, please contact FFHSAZ immediately, we reserve the right to approve or deny any future adoptions and never for any reason relinquish your dog to a shelter. You are welcome to visit our adoptable dogs upon request. any time during regular adoption hours to view the animals that are available for adoption.

Plan to allow one to two hours to complete the adoption process. It may take longer, depending on how many dogs you wish to get acquainted with, your previous experience with pet care, and the number of other appointments that day.

Once you have found a dog that you are interested in adopting, contact Stephanie@ffhsaz.org (602) 695-6232. To ensure the dog chosen is compatible with everyone, all household/family members and pets should interact with the adoptable dog before the adoption is finalized.

To begin the adoption process, all adopters must complete an Adoption Application form. We use an application and interview process to ensure that each dog is adopted to the perfect family home!
